## First Semester Exams

1. First semester exams will be held on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Monday January 18, 19, 20 & 23. **Each session will begin with a 5 minute prep session, 90 minute exam**, and a 15 minute extension for those students who need it. Students are not to be released until the bell, and hallway passes are for emergency purposes only.

3. Dual enrolled students – if a conflict arises between exams and their classes at NMU, it is between the teacher and the student to work out arrangements. It is also

up to the student to make arrangements with their professor at NMU if they must take the exam and therefore, miss their college class.

4. No student traffic is allowed in the halls during exam sessions.
5. If a student is ill during the exam schedule, **a parent/guardian must call the Attendance Office (225-4241) prior** to the scheduled exam. Failure to do so may result in failure of the exam.
6. If a student is absent, the teacher will turn in the exam to the High School Office no later than the end of that school day. Students will be scheduled for make ups after school in the same order as their exams were given (i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> exam missed on Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> exam missed on Thursday, etc.).
7. Students should review the above make-up exam schedules for January 18, January 19, January 20, January 23, and January 24.
8. All school rules apply during the exam sessions, including hats, coats, cell phones, backpacks and headsets.
9. **Students are to be on time for their classes.** The teacher's tardy policy is in effect during exams.
10. If inclement weather occurs during an exam day, an announcement closing school will be made on the radio stations. When school resumes, the canceled day's schedule of exams will be followed.
