2011-2012 PARKING PERMIT POLICY

Parking on school property is a privilege which can be revoked at any time. Student who are provided the opportunity to ride school transportation are encouraged to do so. Students and their parents assume full responsibility for any transportation to and from school not officially provided by the district.

The following guidelines are established for obtaining a parking permit:

1. There will be a fee of \$45.00 for a one-year permit. Students must provide the signed "Application to Drive a Vehicle on School Property" (on reverse side of this page) and proof of registration to obtain a parking permit. Parking permits will be sold on a first come-first serve basis starting with seniors on Tuesday, August 23rd and any remaining permits will be sold to seniors and juniors on a first come first serve basis on Wednesday, August 24th. ****Students with excessive absences and/or outstanding fines from the previous school year will not be eligible to purchase parking permits.****
2. After eligible student parking spaces are filled, a waiting list will be available which will be filled on a first come-first serve basis regardless of class for any slots that become available during the year.
3. The parking permit is to be placed in the **LOWER FRONT WINDOW ON THE PASSENGER'S SIDE** of the vehicle. **IT MUST BE PROPERLY SECURED – NOT TAPED NOR PLACED ON THE DASHBOARD.** Failure to properly place the permit on the windshield may result in being ticketed.
4. Students may only register their vehicle or the vehicle of an immediate family member.
5. Reckless driving, improper parking, tardiness or unexcused absences could result in the loss of parking privileges. The parking lot speed is 5 MPH.
6. Students must park in non-designated parking areas. Students who park in areas designated for visitors, handicapped, Central Office Staff (between blue signs), or Superintendent's area will be ticketed or towed.
7. If a student has a parking permit but needs to drive a different vehicle for a day, he/she must register the temporary vehicle on a daily basis in the High School Office. Failure to do so may result in being ticketed. Temporary vehicles may be registered for a maximum of **five days**.
8. Parking permits are non-transferable. Vehicles with incorrect permits will be ticketed or towed and school discipline (forgery) may follow.
9. If a transfer of a parking permit is necessary (purchase of a new vehicle, damage to vehicle) **the old permit** and \$5.00 are required to purchase a replacement permit.
10. Failure to comply with these rules will result in loss of privileges. If a student's permit is suspended, no fees will be returned.
