**MAPS Superintendent Report:** As of Dec 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020, government accounting standard GASB 84: all activity funds, unless overseen by employee, must be on your own or must come into the general fund. Federal tax id's, 501c3...will have to file for 501c3 status, with tax forms 990, have your own tax exempt status. Or principle could be person of record...if required in general fund. This pertains to all our parent groups with finances.

Adventure-based learning, teachers can set up their classroom however they would like. Email went out to all parents, morning session and afternoon session. All classes in the high school "pod", air conditioned.

**School Board report:** Meeting this week at Sandy Knoll, kids did a presentation of new Math Expressions curriculum. Recognition of MSHS Girls Swim and Dive team first in UP. Boys and girls ski teams won state this year, 7 years in a row for boys, 4 years in a row for girls. Year-end athletics report, lots of kids 4.0 and better in athletics. Purchasing agreement for insurance, making pool bigger for insurance. Security updates approval, and MAREAS election. Raised food service cost of lunch \$0.10...as required by state. Had an update from City of Marquette liaison police officer: seeing and increase in drivers with bus violations, driving by busses with flashing red lights. He will be at dunk tank for project graduation representing police.

## Alternative High School: No report.

**High School**: still \$2600 left after all budget things paid. Staff appreciation breakfast coming up on last day of school hosting for staff...food service has taken over in cafeteria for them, get billed, but well-within budget. Just had Junior prom, scholarship award night, Kaufman awards...lots of kids got both. Lots for 8<sup>th</sup> graders GPA 3.5

**Bothwell Middle School**: Teacher Appreciation week, fiesta lunch. Much appreciated by teachers. Lots of athletic things going on, 7<sup>th</sup> graders at Baycliff, very quiet in the building. Field day ocming, field trips coming up. 5th grade visited Monday and Wednesday of this past week, had to change dates for buses not available...worked out but stressed staff. End of year concerts going well. Grades 6-12 getting new ENVISION 2.0 from Pearson math curriculum.\$121K. Lots of volunteers coming out to help with all events.

**Cherry Creek**: Checker Bus donated bussing for Baycliff 5<sup>th</sup> graders...BIG THANK YOU to them! June 6<sup>th</sup> activity day "bring the games to life." Talent show on last day of school June 10<sup>th</sup>. \$1062 this year in box tops. Budget doing well.

**Graveraet:** Finishing up NWEA testing. Delayed teacher appreciation week because of testing. Every day is themed, teachers fill out card of favorite "stuff" and kids brought surprises for them. A mini-"homecoming" week but for teachers. Spring Concert days, phenomenal music teacher, great concerts. Energy level was great. End of year stuff rolling though fast: activity day, book fair wrapping up tomorrow (did not do one with conferences so doing it now), library closed this week. Short in budget right now, Farm to School fundraiser did not do as well...flip flopped fundraisers and did not do better between the two. Increased the price of yearbook from \$5 to \$10...still a subsidized price, paid \$4k-\$5k for yearbooks. Donation from Girl Scouts gave cookies, and shopped bookfair. President Brandi Thomas gave talk about what Graveraet Parent Association does for school and kids.

**Sandy Knoll:** Teacher Appreciation Week, asked for donations and lots of gift cards given. Full-color yearbooks, every student gets one. Activity day with Double Trouble DJ's "big" games. NWEA testing.
