School Reports:

Additional Item: Three parents spoke at last board meeting regarding lack of a teacher contract. After 17 meetings, no resolution. Some parents very concerned about lack of resolution. Cherry Creek parent group not spending money or time or back millage without resolution to contract. No group going against anyone...but teachers are mad and parent group members are angry or picking a side...lack of contract is causing frustration within parent groups. People are not happy at the schools...does not feel like the same school it was at the beginning of the year.

What do you think we can do as parents? As citizens?

Pressure...e-mails, phone calls...

Sinking fund is coming up...if no teacher support it will not happen...if parents don't support millage it is not going to happen. Some citizens might choose not to support millage to show dissatisfaction with lack of contract agreement.

Seems power structure is with the State. Some districts in state did not follow what state asked. Discussion revolves around points of interest in the debate. Community-school atmosphere and moral seems to be dropping.
