

MAPS COVID-19 Tiered Response Plan 2020-2021

Tiered response to a potential COVID-19 community spread event within the district. This plan will be reviewed by the Marquette County Health Department.

TIER 4

Face to Face Instruction

Occurs When:

- Phase 4 and Phase 5 within the Governor's Plans
- Virus outbreak is detected within our community

District Actions:

- Restrict all access to buildings allowing only students, staff, and qualified visitors
- Comply with MHSAA and the MAPS Athletic Plan for all athletic activities
- Use containment stations for any sick student
- Request medical clearance or 14 day quarantine for symptomatic individuals
- Suspend all activities that are a gathering of community- i.e. graduation, spring concerts, scholarship night, Kaufman Awards, field trips, etc
- Daily sanitizing program of all occupied spaces
- Masks are required to be worn by staff and students
- Social distancing shall occur to the greatest extent possible

TIER 3

Face to Face Instruction

Occurs When:

- Phase 4 and Phase 5 within the Governor's Plans
- Virus is detected within the school system - student or staff

District Actions:

- Follow all Tier 4 guidelines
- Coordinate with the Marquette County Health Department for assistance with contact tracing and general guidance
- Notify all students and staff of a positive COVID-19 case
- Encourage COVID-19 testing of students and staff where appropriate
- Face-to-face instruction continues until Tier 2 guidelines are met

TIER 2

Risk Mitigation - Movement to Online Learning and Suspend Activities

Occurs When:

- Phase 4 and Phase 5 within the Governor's Plans
- Recommendation from the Marquette County Health Department or local health system
 - Uptick in community spread
 - Constraints on local health system
- Factors the district will consider:
 - Trends of illness measured every 30 days with Board review
 - Positive identifiable transmission of illness within determined area
 - Classroom
 - Building
 - District
 - Transportation
 - Extra Curricular Activities
 - Immediate increased surge in illnesses
 - Recommendation or increase in closures from Executive Orders or other regional institutions (e.g. NMU, Negaunee Schools)

District Actions:

- Follow all Tier 4 and Tier 3 guidelines
- Move to online instruction for 14 days or more
- Suspend transportation or other activities for 14 days or more
- Suspend in-person athletic and extracurricular activities

TIER 1

District Closure - Required Movement to Online Learning

Occurs When:

- Phase 1, 2, or 3 within the Governor's Plans
- Recommendation from the Marquette County Health Department or local health system
- After Board Action during monthly review process

District Actions:

- Move instruction online for the remainder of the semester
- Allow only essential school personnel on campus
- Follow all Tier 4, 3, and 2 guidelines
