### MAHS Online Academy (Grades 9-12):

#### Courses & Curriculum:

- MAHS has partnered with Odysseyware to provide students with access to online high school courses.
  - Courses include core and elective courses

- Courses are taught by highly qualified MAHS teachers.
  - Students receive instruction and support from their local teachers.
  - Teachers receive specialized training in online learning to ensure all students maximize their educational experience.
- Courses are provided on a quarter, semester, and/or yearly basis.
  - Students enroll in 7 courses per quarter.
- Curriculum and instruction is based on national and state standards
- Online courses follow the same curriculum as MAHS face-to-face courses.
- Courses for grades 9-12 are based on Michigan Merit Curriculum requirements and standards

**Flexibility:**

- Students have the ability to work on coursework from home at any time.
- Students have access to accelerated learning opportunities.
- Our online learning platform provides 24/7 access to online curriculum and gives students, teachers, and guardians full visibility into progress and grades.

**Learning Supports:**

- Students are assigned a teacher to assist them in their online learning.
- Built-in accommodations, including having text read to students and additional time to complete assignments.
- Students have a variety of communication options available to them to receive help, including phone calls, emails, messaging within the online system, and virtual meeting time with teachers.
